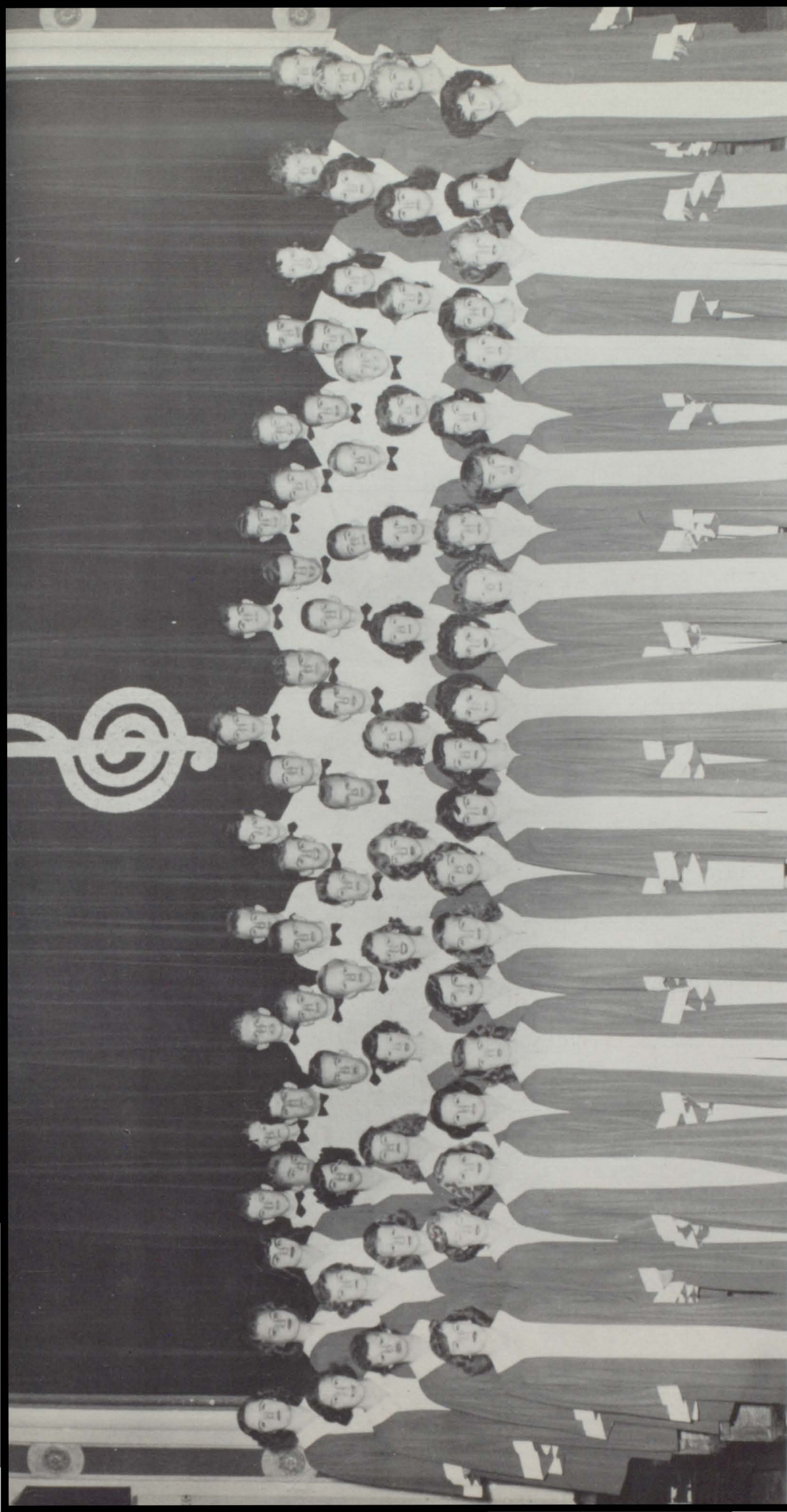
The various instrumental ensembles and soloists have entertained on numerous occasions for local organizations, conventions, and other programs.
