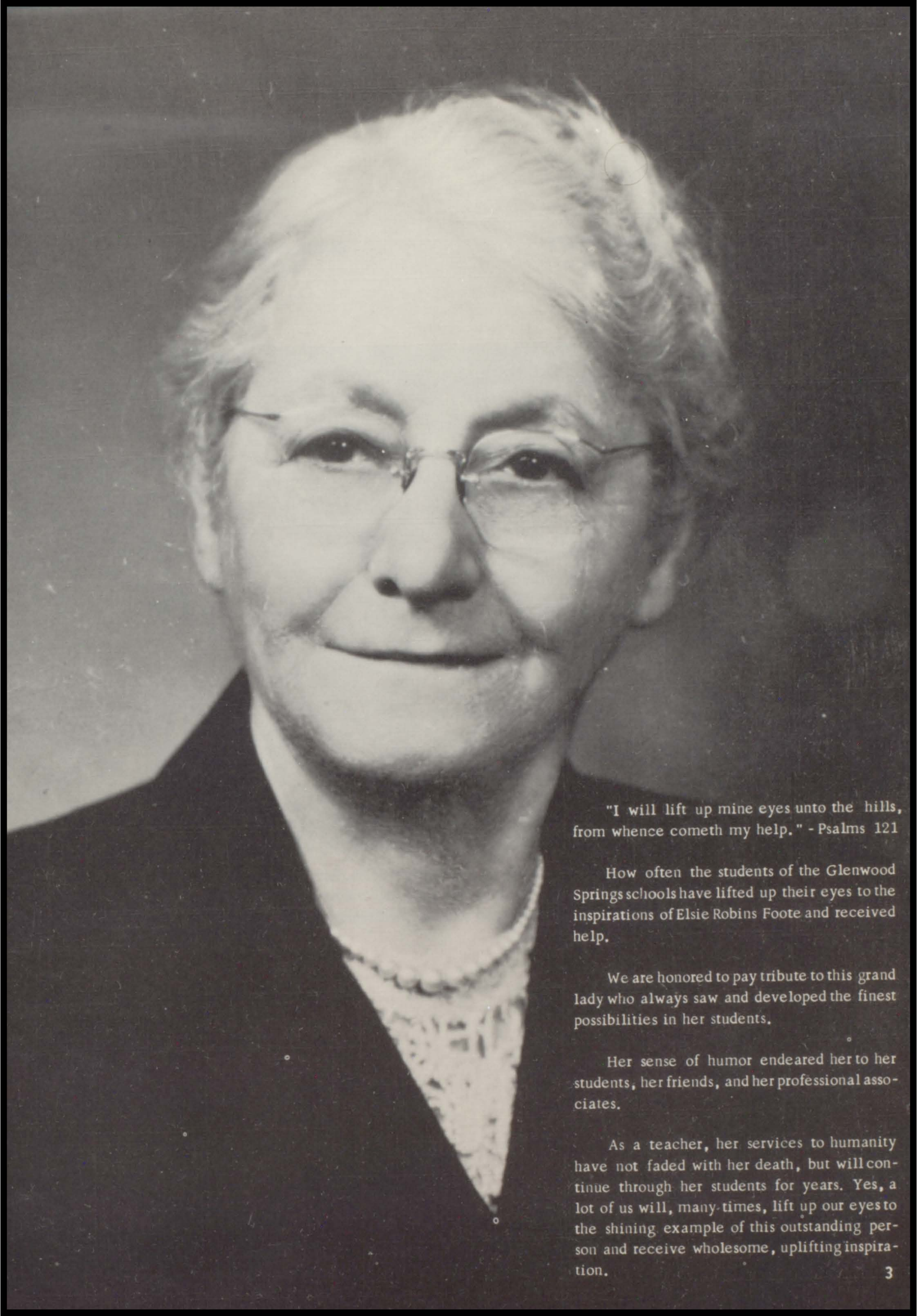


"No greater compliment can be paid to any man than to call him a teacher."
