Captain Donald C. Patch, a 1951 graduate of Glenwood Springs High School, left an enviable record that ranged from excellent scholarship to drama, from student government to All-Conference honors in athletics, from music to literature and even included the start of his life profession -- flying.

After attending the University of Colorado, he entered the Air Force and Officers' Training. He received his commission and wings in 1956 and was recognized as the top cadet in the United States. Instructing other young officers to fly jet aircraft was his prime assignment. Later, he was placed on the instructors evaluation board.

In 1965 he volunteered for intensive training to prepare himself for what he considered his most important undertaking -- flying close support ground cover missions in the A-1E Skyraider in Viet Nam. He served with dedication and determination until he lost his life on a flying mission in October, 1965. For his actions, abilities, leadership and way of life, he was posthumously awarded the Silver Star, The Air Medal and The Purple Heart.
