 narrowed about the upper fence
 looks like rain, quite cold.
 Will & I went to town, got a letter for
 Madeworth. gave it to John. Mr. & Mrs. Moore
 came over & staid until late.

Thursday May 5th 1870
 I took on the garden. Mother, Mary,
 Geo. & Port, & My B Smith, over to town
 to get their photos taken. Hazzard
 came here selling sewing machines.
 My B, Mother, Geo. & I went with him.
 They came home about the middle of
 the afternoon. Hazzard came again
 just as they came home.
 had a slight frost last night

Friday May 6th 1870
 George's plow corn all day go to
 school meeting at Mad. had
 a sing. had a talk with John. Mary
 got some gear of mine

Saturday May 7th 1870
 Finish harrowing the corn, mackeron
 the bed opposite Smith's very warm
 & sultry all day.

May 8th 1870.

Sabbath go up to Forts he shaved one
 out down. I went up to V. A. A.
 to see if Mrs. Wadst would get down
 I went after them with the males
 J. O. Butler preached. got home
 at two o'clock. went to Sabbath
 school & after stayed at home.
 Mame & John Sweet Skeeter came down
 Mrs. Green was at my house. Took
 Mame Mather, Man. Green sweet to
 meeting with Mills horses. Took
 to a load. they passed me on the
 hill I got home about half an hour
 after they did took Mame & Sweet home
 M. & Mame.

Monday May 9th 1870
 Help get up fathers
 load. he starts after dinner to the
 moon farm expects to bring a load
 sawn wood home. plant pumpkins
 in the afternoon. Mr. Sights
 his two sons came down. A man
 stayed all night with a drove of
 cattle. very warm but have
 had a frost for four nights in
 succession.

May 10th 1870

Tuesday plant squashes go to town
with no light wagon had a
very time dont get meeting
but late met Mrs. M. G. Limited
Garrison got some goods from
Stales nose Miller told Willy
he wanted to be a doctor have
Selena got horse at two o'clock
Mr. Green was here to give Mary
her lesson plant pumpkin seed
Clark from Red Grove came
to the field where I was at work
expected to go to town tonight
Will got his back up about his horse
rode in with Johnny eat oranges
and shot the seeds at one another all
the way home R. Aight went in
with us seen Morgans girls
got home about midnight.

Dig strawbeery plants Aman
wanted plants at 2.00 per bunch
would not let him have them
Farrar brought the machine
Leheneys came from Golden
went to town with Wads
father came home about 6 o'clock

No sign of Richard unless go to Sabbath & work. Spooner & I do not take any part in the less. All go to town but giving time to the one & Richard red in post. The old folks ride in the other way you stayed in town & got a drive at the farm. got some 10 minutes by one twelve.

Monday May 16th 1870

Very windy & warm Will Sp. & port help put up fence. Father went to town to be qualified. got a letter from farm on 14th & up the call pasture fence. Went over to light with Richard Mrs. Mayfield was at our house. were light home quite windy.

Tuesday May 17th 1870

port & I clean out the ditch up the byer get the water down and then wanted us to come up to the party started. about dark Mother got out & I in. He told Mary she had better stay at home but I da take & I went in light wagon. Charly's sick dog got home about 11:30 or 12:30. Very cold and windy.

May 18th 1870

Wednesday. Got up late on account of
being up late, tend to the water & pump
for pots corn & potatoes in the afternoon
port & I clean my ditch on way
to Wolfe's field John Cox's man helped
Mother was madder than ever, she has
been telling her a lot of stuff about
our going to France had quite
approved last night but comes
the potatoes & potatoes very still
& cool looks like rain in the west
May went up to Wadsworth's to see some
thing about her machine. Will help
Wadsworth's clean ditch

Thursday May 19th 1870

Commence irrigating port came
wanted me to help on the ditch
finish the ditch before noon turn
the water on ports wheat
port & I plant potatoes for me.
Mr Dindley came up to where port was
had to come after potatoes those and
time rained a little.

Friday May 20th 1870

Plow the ditch in the pasture
until noon port & I then went to
town bought myself a coat & vest,
port & I got some meat for B & F for
Phineas. got the largest orange that I
ever saw. got a letter for B & F, as well
we went to Wolfe's to the church meeting
Mary played on the organ some very
enjoying home, looked like rain

May 21st 1870

Saturday commenced shoveling out the ditch John W. came up to where I was working talked quite awhile got the potatoes near the road after dinner Father helped me we got to the road & then we sent up some lettuce & onions to Peers to send to Lefeyenne. Bright helped in the work we saved a little went up to see about the over-ditch no water in it at all commenced for the day. None came down by the ridge with a bogues for May.

Sabbath May 22nd 1870

Got up late dressed & started over to the coal prospect went to Wadsworth's Mine & John went along staid about 2 hours picking specimens of flowers Mine & Mary went ahead we came after awhile John & I sit on the bridge outside Richard met D. Angove's Mother was there they came directly home after they knew that we were there Mary & I got dinner Mine & John took dinner with us. we then went to Sabbath school I gave me an orange the water had run over the road by the school house High walked home with May cut I took some lettuce & onions to Peers with persimmons Peers brought the boys over the creek with the can

Monday May 23rd 1870

Monday, finished the ditch in the
field, got the water to the potatoes
and the water stopped, all Wolff came
down to get help to turn in water
was so tired that I could hardly
more. weather quite warm & breeze
like rain

Tuesday May 24th 1870

Start up the ditch after we finished
planting my potatoes took quite
a number of men turned in quite a
head five Port came after we got
through work Skilleter ducked
Dick Wolff sent one man Big Ed
sent one John Gilmore, Port with
I got home about 4 o'clock done nothing
afterwards

Wednesday May 25th 1870

I started up the bayou found the water went
up to Johnny Yokum's cut Longans &
Gilmore's ditches met first of the field
going up the creek I went eat my
breakfast in the wagon took ten
men this time got a good head
first & I went to town got a
letter for Angones, went to prayer
meeting met Eve & Tom Kevs, came
home with Port & Cort, very warm

May 26th 1870

Thursday We worked on the ditch by Wolffs Charley was there with his man & team. Planted potatoes & corn and planted corn Dick cleaned ditch for part lost a shovel for High. Coole's man came along after a while Met Kimber & his wife in the lane stayed all night no water in the basin yet I came by Wolffs,

Friday May 27th 1870

Will post Dick & Charley Lept's man & I start to the head of the basin rained a little post got some bread & butter we tried to make a big head of water had to dam & ditch through Slatters field found Mrs. McDermott at our house when we got home Kimbers came directly after they all stayed all night Dick & I went over to Angone's took a letter to Mrs. Angone he had some trouble with Patrick & Manhart. look like rain in the evening cleared after dark

Saturday May 28th 1870

Went to town with Angone got a pair of croquet. Angone & I eat a pie in Kethmans seen Greene in town just from the R. rode home with Eric Bens set the croquet up played two games helped with looks like rain again Mrs. Lamb was here Miss Penn stayed will went to town with Billy Jackson

May 29th 1870

Sabbath Got up pretty early went over to Ahngorgs & saw if Patrick would lead the dam out but they said not come we talked by the bridge & with a wheel Charley came along with a buggy I rode home with him & after dinner I changed clothes & after dinner I started to saddle horse took some testaments & rode part way with Charley. Mary got in at the foot of the hill he & I went to Logans walked out where the creek above the house talked about going to Cal & found Mary said to me to meeting with Wadsworth & rode the mile & got there on pretty time. Sister provided me to get at ditch wanted me to try & get it. I attend to get home after 11 o'clock

Monday May 30th 1870
 Got breakfast very late started up to see pond he had just dried & by noon and I lost it. had a talk about things had a talk with those Miller & saw about horses & got home before noon. Fred & I planted 29 squashes. Mrs. came down Mother &etal went up. There found Mr & seth together in the door Dick with him to the place all day with driving very windy but they with a disagreeable

Tuesday May 31st 1870.

Start to Valmont With Charles & Alty
get there before noon could get no fish because
of the wind went to Boulder met Dick's
cart. went to Clusters stayed till late
got supper at Valmont fished a while
caught nothing slept in the snow
very cold & windy

Wednesday June 1st 1870.

Get up early go down & fish a
while with hooks caught 6 went
to breakfast, Charles bought 15th of
Rancho at 2 cts. start home
about eight o'clock. get home
just after dinner Cort was at
the shop met Day at Kniveng
went to prayer meeting in evening
the afternoon with Mary was
late but few out. Mary asked
Mrs. Wadsworth to let Anne go
to strains with us picked the
first strawberries Will is & take the
Anne lost her teeth permanent & Queing
Thursday June 2nd 1870.

Help some in the garden of Mr.
Willy water on the hill; Mr. Brown
& Jimmy come down and we help
look for Anne's pin could not
find it. We dig a ditch to the
squashes got opening wagon went
to ferrins got the barrels & sheets brought
Anne & John to stay with us met Dan cart by post
going up to Wadsworths they came back & played
croquet till ten o'clock then went home
all went to bed

June 4th 1870

Saturday Start [unclear] at sunrise had to go after Charley with the wagon had a pleasant trip most of the way got there between 10 & 11 o'clock no one at home but Stebbins he went & borrowed a rain we tried to catch some fish but failed times with a hook but with no success. went to look at the grape vine fell into the creek I caught her. went to the house and done nothing else killed a skunk made me sick Smith came down to Mayfield's I left the room had guitar play with the rope had a play in the granary slept in the granary with Charley called to breakfast by 10

Sabbath June 5th 1870

called to breakfast by Thomas. after breakfast we took a walk up the ditch picked flowers all the way Mrs Lord her handkerch we looked for it some layed under the wagon and went over the ones to look at land over there like real well. came back hitch up Mr Mayfield gave us some thing to eat on the road started home at 12 past three Charley & John slept at the hind end of the wagon port drove most to churches John down home part some man & I slept under the blanket - got home at 11 o'clock was awful sore

June 8th 1870.

Monday took the wagon home & got the harness of Swadley talked to Wadsworth about the ditch on St Vrain. came home & helped get up Wills load repaired his wagon Mary started to school. very warm & dry. Brooker & his boys staid all night with their lightning rods.

Tuesday June 9th 1870

Finished picking strawberries. loaded Will & he shod his horses started at 11 o'clock Mrs Clark & Barnes of Golden came aft to strawberry sold them 20 quarts for 75 cts. plowed & harrowed & sown cauliflower in the afternoon turned the water on the potatoes aight & Ordre came from the mountains John & Mary to Lake George to Colorado City

Wednesday June 8th 1870.

Went to Wads: with pert after the wagon ground coffee for John helped them get it go to town with pert on the mule. saw the wagon's bell for almost nothing. came home Brooker had been after strawberries for Golden he fell in to the creek & got wet all over went to pray or meeting went after I saw she would not go. rode home with the cows. they blame they would be split they or get it.

June 9th 1870

Thursday went up to see Wads about going over to St. Vrain helped him on the night
 Tom Miller came along with
 old Thomas team hoveed in the
 Rhubarb & cabbage & planted
 some of the fruit. Also potatoes
 very warm hoveed in the straw
 played croquet till after 11 o'clock
 very cold after night

June 10th 1870

Friday Woke up by mother got up &
 fed & harnessed eat breakfast
 started to St. Vrain about 9 am
 got there before noon stopped a little
 while at May fields then crossed
 the creek only the line through
 pretty near to Bushington camped
 by a lake fished some after dark
 went to bed early slept poorly
 Wads slept in the wagon part
 I slept on the ground
 Will started to the mt with a 8 quarts

Saturday June 11th 1870

Went up the creek to survey
 down got discouraged at a ditch
 on the north talked with a fellow
 about it found we would have to
 make about 20 or 25 miles of ditch
 (rough estimate) and concluded to
 return home did so immediately
 spoke to church about pigs let me
 send home this sent to home about 4 o'clock

June 12th 1870

Sabbath post & Gotting & Betty Dick
then we went up to hear McCann's
preach Mr. Green came up & went
with us. Mrs. Angus came up
Cort & Wolffs were absent except
Fair & Charley
went to Sabbath school a good many
Mr. Hamilton preached in the
evening.

Monday June 13th 1870.

All hands picked strawberries
Mr. Green helped & went to the
hills with Will, he took 133 quon.
I plowed some & hauled a little
went to see Cort's garden
went to bed early all hands very
tired

Tuesday June 14th 1870

plow corn & cabbage & hoe
the cabbage & tomatoe Mrs.
came down after some flower
plants. we played croquet
I carried the plants home for
her. Mr & Mrs Angus were
at home when I got home

June 15th 1870

Wednesday Start to town with
the big wagon Mother put
Mrs. Argyer crossed at Dudley
creek pretty high got a letter
for George, Walter & me they had
a notice of some money at craters
got my pony Hetta & Fanni
one for Will, got me a pair of boots
got collars for the horses
& various little things
came near getting in the creek
picked strawberries at 10 o'clock
home Will got home an hour
by noon
Mme helped us pick some
Ransy came, Mary Intends to
stay with Mme, went to pray or
meeting, walked with Mme, she had the
headach very bad, Mary did not stay

Thursday June 16th 1870

Finished the waxes of the bottom
finished picking & loading the
strawberries got 18 quarts, started
about 2 o'clock, now come early
go over to the lake with Spoon
& put swimming, did not go via
rope across the creek with Dan
Sprover, played with me
looked like did some but I guess
none will fall soon
Ransy come just ahead of a
now

June 17th 1870

Friday Father & I commenced our various business. When we were in the office our mother has the head ache very bad indeed & when I returned at 1 o'clock with the paper. I left my wife across the creek. I bought 9 wax or a Lariat & a bottle of Sandalwood came in by Bonds bridge & I to home just before sunset. Mrs. & Mrs. Parson's went away by on horse backs Mr. Green came up - after me to meeting with him & my mother some object & they were upon the office. Mr. Green led the meeting. Mr. Green led in an argument that he could not claim & on the lesson had some music & singing.

Saturday June 18th 1870

Very warm do not little hot a storm & sent to town by Gussing for some paper. I David Green they came home by taking a quart of butter to Mrs. Wadsworth & found Mrs. in her bayonet found the folks ahead at home.

June 19th 1870

Sabbath Got up late eat breakfast alone
Went home with Charley had some first
rate wine & pie eat Dr. came home
& sit a while then went up to L.S.
a good many in a committee for
Ratston invited us to join them
in the fourth voted to do so Mary
and I got very mad about the money
in the little boxes Mrs Mary put
& I went to Ratston to gather flowers
Mr Green refused to go along came
home pretty near night.

Monday June 20th 1870

Rick Barnes until noon Mr Light
came over from Angony he helped
us some got 10¢ off. he started about
2 o'clock old man New came to see
about some for a festival at school
Mrs Angony Mr & Mrs Light left
& Port take supper

Tuesday June 21st 1870

Port & I start & wal early to look at
the ditch got up to Phillips before
the middle of the afternoon looked
at the line and return to Phillips
took supper then Perry came out to
see the floor.

June 22nd 1870

Wednesday started home early, cut a lead broke down just above the gate unloaded & slant home with a pole under the axles it rained on us got wet got home at 2 o'clock rained all afternoon and all night went to Quinings the RR came to Denver Parker was the first man landed in Denver

Thursday June 23rd

Father & I pick strawberries in the evening make boxes pretty near all day we went to dance Will & I went down to store got a letter from Jimmy for I went to Wads found the in bed came home steps with pen

Friday June 24th 1870

Finish picking strawberries start Will & the mountains about noon Mr Angus came over to fit a bucket Mr Beegley came notified us to work on the road next Wed & Thurs teachers meeting here Mame came down after school we played croquet Father & I pulled weeds at the pear Mr Green came about this time meeting was not held all night Mame staid because it was so muddy went to bed at 2 o'clock

June 25th 1870

Saturday Ned & I plow corn all day very warm. One bend came down & talked a while - quit early, shared & I went over to Kaletoke to bathe but the musketoos were so bad that I went up to Dasing's he was out at home & I bathed in the creek below his house found sponges here talked about the journey a while he stayed all night with me

Sabbath June 26th 1870

Late before we got up sent Ned off the saddle & pony we went up to the brick school house horseback took dinner at Beeley's came home then to Sabbath school at our horse they had torn the library open wanted me to go reading but her father would not let her took the saddle horn & pony Hugg was so angry trying to make a stage found Green & Gilman at home

Monday June 27th 1870

Plowed & plowed in the garden pretty good all day rained some but very warm Will wanted me to go town with him

Tuesday June 28th 1870

June 29th 1870

Tuesday, pick strawberries Mrs Smith
& wife & Dr King came & took
all the berries we had
Mother Will sent a basket to town
met Mrs _____ with her carter
wage got some tobacco for King
got some plants for Mary
got home about ten o'clock went
to bed late very warm & sultry

Wednesday 30th 1870

Went to work on the road at Kill
Allens worked down to the lane
bridge had 14 at work went to
prayer meeting went to Allens

Thursday July 30th 1870

Worked on the road all day when
came home the folks were just
as father & mother were getting
my wife was at the house Spooner
came down in the evening. Mr & Mrs
Wads took supper we played
croquet & her & I sweet played quills
a while. I was very tired.

July 1st 1870

Friday, Hauled coon by the barn,
spiced cabbage, helped father how
the balance of the carrots,
travels, warm & disagreeable
played croquet with George
& Will, went to teachers meeting at
Wadsworth's

First ever 7/1/70

Saturday (July 2nd 1870)
Hauled cabbage, spiced cabbage, and ordered
Hollis pants on the machine
started to town about 11 o'clock with
Mime, George, Mary, and kids, got
to town at four, bought a seat, uniforms
Mary & George got their pants taken
got a rat, Mime refused to have his
taken, got home, not much work, it
took Mime home, talked to Maria till 6
scout had with a crackers

First ever 7/1/70

Sabbath, July 3rd 1870

Went to Sabbath school, Mime came home with
our spinner, took the wagon up after water
& went down & staid with Charley, slept
with three of us in a bed very warm *

July 4th 1870

Monday Charley & I got up twenty nine after
 14 dressed got some cake & picked a bag of
 apple got home before they were awakened
 Spooner by throwing stones on the barn
 fined the anvils off stones eat bread
 & started to Valmott just before 3 o'clock
 got on the wrong road I was a little
 lame lost her teaming got to the
 ground 2 o'clock of ten had a pretty
 good time they commenced dancing
 before we left - I slept most all the
 way home - Mame broke her comb
 about 11 o'clock get this day Mame
 all night got home about ten o'clock
 Charley went to town after we came
 home

Tuesday July 5th 1870

sharpen the cultivator teeth & plow
 cabbage & pumpkins Mame went home
 alone very warm rained in the evening
 went to bed early

rained until about noon pulled weeds

Friday July 8th 1870

Very late when we got up - very warm picked peas for light until noon we then put up Rhubarb & beets play croquet with George & the rest of the young folks Mr Charles & I went to town to go to Greeley. Mother had the headache Mr Knight & Angus came down dog takes to the big ditch we walk from there stayed at the Barnardo Hotel

Saturday July 9th 1870

Start after some breakfast but find none start halfpast 6 Mr Knight had a fine ride got to Greeley go after & get some breakfast & walk to the grove about a mile very warm sit around till about three o'clock then laid around till 2 o'clock after fine when the train arrived from Cheyenne on the half way home on the platform got acquainted with Miss Hewitt got to Denver all the afternoon Will met us at the depot. July 10th 1870

Sabbath After breakfast went to look
for Charley not knowing that he had
gone home & stayed with Seca who
then started home & foot walked
from Synons to the creek in a hour

rest were at church Jake & his
bro & sister came & had dinner
Pan Rosa & McCornick also
went to sabbath school found the
book case torn open again
stopped at wadsworths while

Monday July 11th 1870

Worked in the garden rained a little
George & I made some frames for the flowers
pull weeds out of the corn had a general
gaze of Croquet in the evening but got
sick drinking

Tuesday July 12th 1870

Father & I hoveled onions all day
at very warm day Will work on the
machine Cap Light starts home
Mr Green play ed croquet with us

July 13th 1870

Wednesday Father Mother Harry & George
 start to Coal creek to look at the
 ditch & pick gooseberries I hooped
 in the turnips opposite first house
 went to prayer meeting old Dr. was
 over after quite very windy in the evening

Before breakfast light came

Half light off & then plow potatoes
 until noon Nangay came over to where

 took George to town & got a letter
 from & me for Wads. was in mine at home
 when I got home

July 16th 1870.

Saturday Turn the water on the potatoes
in the low field. Did not see
Mother Mrs Madam's Anger all
go to town calculate to get back
by noon got back between 3 & 6
in the evening went up the bay one
had a good wash out feet. Had to
go to bed early being very tired.

Sabbath July 17th 1870

Got up late help make the
ice cream for Anger. Went up
to Wads. Took up the letters which
Anger had with me we had a dinner
by our selves the folks had all
gone to Anger's went to Sunday
Morn came up from Anger
After Sabbath school we that is

Friday July 22nd 1870

turn, a load of us get some of the
castings and some other repairs
for the machine, got a letter from
Walter with her photo in it & a photo

Saturday July 28th 1870

Tuesday Nov 14th 1870.
Start late travel 22 1/2 mi stop at Miss Miller they had an accordion & we had music

Wednesday Nov 15th 70
Saidy our had very warm weather took a walk on the hill after spingous find none.

Thursday 16th 1870.
Started 20 min after 8 traveled 22 mi stopped at the Henfams was very much pretty cold

Friday 18th
traveled 30 miles. stopped at Fristers first rate place met a young man from Blooming ton

Saturday 19th 1870
Started late met a horse thief on the road go to Trinidad a 3 yelabs had very rough roads got a bed at the hotel snowed like six

Wednesday 7th Father starts to the Mts to take grub to Mill & Ed met Swift at Woods walked to meeting with Mary Ann & then rode home with Cato

Thursday 8th Went to town with Swift got a letter from Betta M^e Got the vegetables he paid one \$17.00

Friday 9th Snowed all day very cold

Saturday 10th Fed hog feed Johny got some onions

Sunday 11th Went to preaching below took men & Johny & Swift went to S. Day was to preach but failed to come

Monday 12th Went up to ports invited the folks to Mother's & Father's party very cold & stormy

Tuesday 13th Help Mother & Siggie all day very cold the folks commenced coming about noon had a splendid time

Wednesday 14th Helped Wolff's raise the barn went to the meeting with Swift helped him shell corn at Woods

Thursday 15th Make a shed over the Kettle

Friday 16th Get the steers from Lou filled him went to the school Ed went to party after his skates did not go to the teachers meeting

Saturday 17th 1870 Finished the shed very cold & disagreeable all day went to hands to school room for Swift - Mrs Ed & Molly John Ed & I went in the wagon to school with us but he stopped at the school house & returned home

Dec 18th 1830

Sunday Swift preached at the M. took dinner at Wads. went to ... meeting of the committee of Wads. Mr. Brown preached like & ran gun & sleep.

Monday 19 Started to school. Went to Lorys. in the evening took Anne & John in the sleigh took Anne riding after we left home. talked things over.

Tuesday 20 Very cold froze my ear going to school. Anne told me they intended to come to our house & sing. Fields & Proctor came. they staid all night with Anne & left in the same bed.

Wednesday Very cold frost flying in the air all day. went up to Wads took the paper & tried to ball some eggs for Swift but fail. Add Charles died. Johnson m^d 1835.

Thursday 21 Expected Mother make my party. went to school at noon. still very cold. the cars had to stop with 2 engines & one car the snow drifted on the tracks so they could not run.
